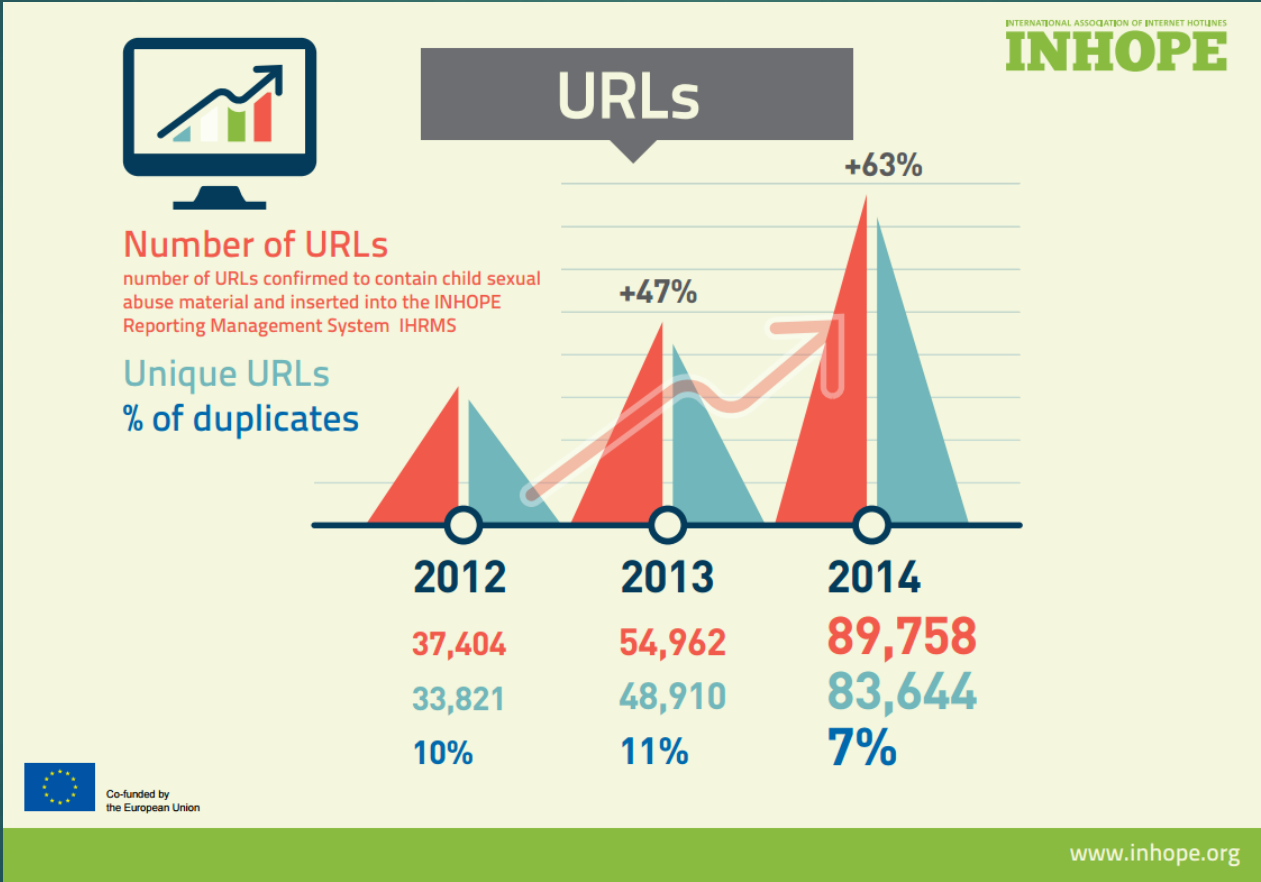

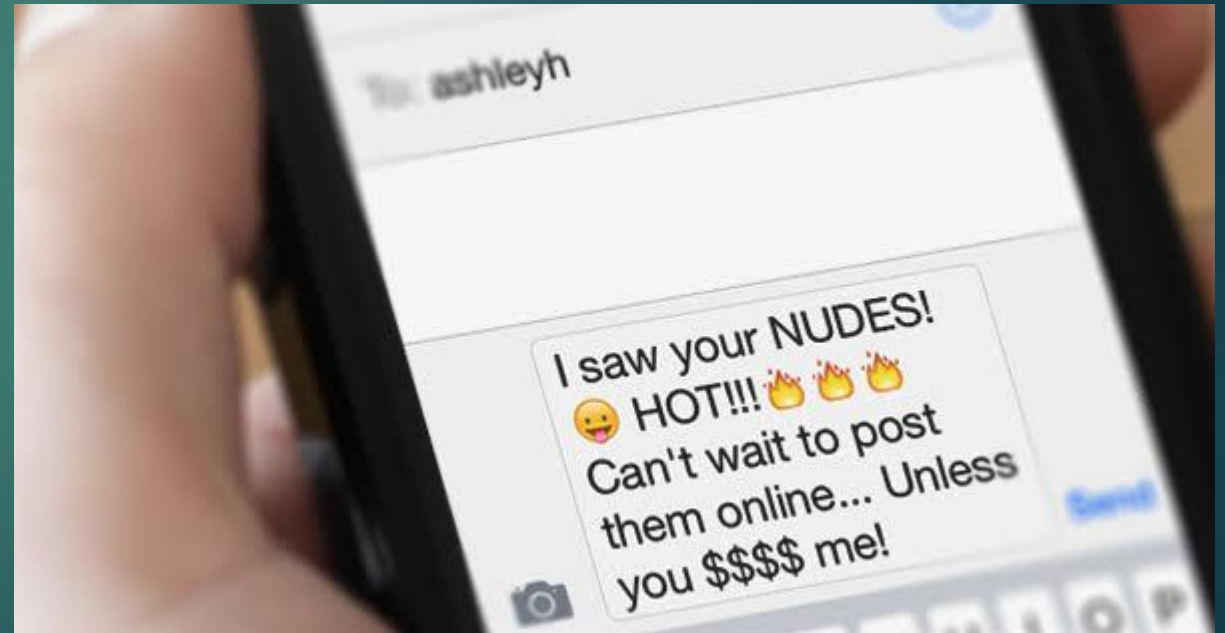
# Self-Generated Material
